ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

- 1. United Arab Emirates: Update: Etihad Airways to partially resume flights from 1 May following suspension to contain spread of COVID-19
- 2. Denmark: Update: Country to permit some small businesses to reopen on 20 April as part of process to ease COVID-19 lockdown; borders remain closed

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- 1. Hungary: Update: Government to extend COVID-19 lockdown measures by one week
- 2. Sweden: Government extends entry ban for another 30 days because of COVID-19
- 3. **U.K.:** Update: COVID-19 lockdown measures to remain in effect for at least another three weeks, government says
- 4. Poland: Update: Prime minister says country's borders to remain closed until at least 3 May
- 5. Portugal: Update: Country extends COVID-19 lockdown measures until 2 May
- 6. Bulgaria: Government bans travel to, from capital city Sofia starting 17 April amid COVID-19 outbreak

ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

7. **Japan:** Update: Nationwide state of emergency declared until 6 May because of COVID-19 outbreak

 Georgia: Government bans movement of all private vehicles until 21 April to prevent spread of COVID-19

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

9. No updates received

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

- 10. Senegal: Update: Government extends flight ban until 31 May as part of effort to contain COVID-19
- 11. **Egypt**: Public transport to be halted across country on 20 April to limit crowds during major holiday, prevent spread of COVID-19

NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

12. U.S.: Update: New York's lockdown measures extended until 15 May

AIRLINES:

- 1. **Fiji, New Zealand:** Fiji Airways to provide evacuation flights between Fiji and New Zealand from 17 April
- 2. France: Corsair suspends flights until early June because of COVID-19
- 3. French Polynesia: Air Tahiti Nui extends flight suspensions until 31 May because of COVID-19
- 4. Switzerland: Update: SWISS to continue minimum operations to 17 May because of COVID-19
- 5. **Austria:** Update: Austrian Airlines extends cessation of regular flight operations until 17 May because of COVID-19
- 6. India: Update: Vistara, GoAir to resume flights from 4 May after suspension because of COVID-19 outbreak
