# ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Global: Update: CDC reissues its warning against nonessential international travel as COVID-19 concerns continue.

## Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

- Montenegro: <u>Update</u>: Government shortens curfew in cautious easing of COVID-19 lockdown
- Poland: <u>Update</u>: Country may reopen hotels in May as part of easing of COVID-19 restrictions, government spokesman says
- 3. **Spain**: <u>Update</u>: Prime minister says government will begin easing COVID-19 lockdown measures in second half of May
- 4. **Vietnam**: <u>Update</u>: Civil aviation authority seeks to resume all domestic routes from 23 April after expiry of government order of social distancing in some provinces

5. **Saudi Arabia**: <u>Update</u>: Government plans to ease curfew hours in several cities during month of Ramadan

- 6. **France**: Government stops all flights outside Schengen zone because of COVID-19, some flights still operating to repatriate French nationals
- Georgia: <u>Update</u>: Government extends state of emergency until 22 May because of COVID-19

#### **ASIAN / AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:**

- 8. **Thailand**: Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports about flight reductions, airport closures across country because of COVID-19
- Japan: <u>Update</u>: All extra Shinkansen services will be canceled from 24 April because of COVID-19 concerns

#### **LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:**

 Venezuela: CDC warns against nonessential travel because of health infrastructure breakdown

#### **AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:**

11. **Angola**: Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports borders remain closed with few flights departing country

#### **NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:**

12. **Canada, U.S.:** <u>Update</u>: Air Canada suspends all flights to U.S. through 22 May after extension of border closure

#### **AIRLINES:**

13. Luxemburg: Update: Luxair extends flight suspensions until 30 May because of COVID-19
