ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

1. **Serbia:** Belgrade Airport may reopen from 1 May; final decision awaited from government
2. **Portugal:** COVID-19 state of emergency will be lifted from 3 May
3. **Oman, United Arab Emirates:** COVID-19 restrictions eased for some businesses
4. **United Arab Emirates:** Dubai hopes to reopen for tourists as early as July
5. **Serbia:** Government will restart bus, rail services, allow commercial flights in first half of May
6. **Poland:** Hotels to be open over summer holidays as part of easing of COVID-19 restrictions, government spokesman says
7. **Lithuania:** Update: Passenger flights may resume on 10-15 May to some countries amid COVID-19 concerns
8. **Austria:** Gatherings of up to 10 people permitted as government begins loosening COVID-19 lockdown restrictions
9. **U.S.:** Three major airlines announce measures to reduce spread COVID-19 on flights as restrictions ease.

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

10. **Serbia:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on travel and transit restrictions imposed by government to prevent spread of COVID-19
11. **Europe, Iran, U.S.:** Update: Romania authorities extend flight ban to several EU countries, Iran and U.S. because of COVID-19
12. **Russia:** President extends COVID-19 lockdown until 11 May
13. **Czech Republic:** Parliament extends state of emergency until 17 May to slow spread of COVID-19
14. **Azerbaijan:** Country's borders to remain closed until 31 May to curb spread of COVID-19

ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

15. **Philippines:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on extension of community quarantine in several regions through 15 May
16. **Kyrgyz Republic:** Government extends state of emergency until 10 May because of COVID-19

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

17. **Costa Rica:** Border restrictions may be extended beyond 15 May because of COVID-19

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

18. **Egypt:** State of emergency extended for three months because of 'dangerous' health, security conditions
19. **Botswana:** U.S. Embassy reports government extends period of extreme social distancing through 7 May; flights remain suspended amid COVID-19 concerns

NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

20. **No updates**

AIRLINES:

21. **Europe: Wizz Air** plans **to restart flights** from Vienna to 20 destinations, with first services running from 1 May
22. **Thailand: Bangkok Airways** **to resume flights** to Samui on 15 May after suspension because of COVID-19; Koh Samui Airport expected to reopen on 15 May
23. **Turkey: Turkish Airlines** **extends suspension** of all flights until 28 May because of COVID-19
24. **Kazakhstan: Air Astana** will **resume flights** between Almaty and Nur-Sultan from 1 May after suspension because of COVID-19
25. **Ghana: Domestic flights** **to resume** on 1 May after suspension because of COVID-19
