ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent bans in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- 1. **Slovenia:** Authorities introduce mandatory 14-day quarantine for most people entering country from 4 April in bid to curb spread of COVID-19
- 2. **Sweden:** U.S. Embassy reports on temporary suspension of flights to Newark Liberty International Airport through 20 April
- 3. Ukraine: U.S. Embassy reports stricter quarantine measures in place beginning 6 April
- 4. Germany: Lufthansa extends COVID-19 cuts until 3 May
- 5. Turkey: Government places 31 cities under quarantine because of COVID-19
- 6. Turkey: Turkish Airlines suspends all domestic flights until 20 April amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 7. Luxembourg: U.S. Embassy reports international travel options still available from Luxembourg to France, Germany, Netherlands
- 8. Austria: Austrian Airlines extends flight suspension until 3 May because of COVID-19
- 9. Belgium: Non-essential travel ban reinstated because of COVID-19
- 10. Italy: Some airport workers to stage 24-hour strike on 11 May
- 11. U.K.: Northern Rail to reduce train services across region on 5 April because of COVID-19
- 12. U.K.: Train services will be further reduced on 6 April amid COVID-19 pandemic;
- 13. Germany, Iran: Iran Air suspends all flights between countries amid COVID-19 restrictions
- 14. Spain: Government to extend state of emergency until 26 April because of COVID-19
- 15. **Southeast Europe:** Border between Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina closed until 6 April because of COVID-19; Croatia, Montenegro also close all border crossings to Bosnia and Herzegovina

- 16. Sweden, U.K.: All commercial flights between countries will be suspended from 9 April until further notice because of COVID-19
- 17. Slovakia: Government plans to restrict personal movement from 8-13 April
- 18. Israel: Government plans total lockdown on 8 April to prevent spread of COVID-19

ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

- 19. Azerbaijan: U.S. Embassy reports on government rules limiting personal movement
- 20. **Philippines:** U.S. Embassy reports on face mask requirement in areas under enhanced community quarantine
- 21. Japan: U.S. Embassy reports on significant increase in COVID-19 cases
- 22. **Japan:** Prime minister to invoke state of emergency on 7 April to further restrict movement amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 23. Singapore: praised for its COVID-19 response, goes into lockdown as cases rise April 4.
- 24. Thailand: All passenger flights temporarily halted from landing in country to curb outbreak of COVID
- 25. **Russia:** Government temporarily suspends all flights in, out of country from midnight because of COVID-19, including those for repatriating nationals
- 26. **India:** Air India halts flight bookings until 30 April as it awaits government decision on lockdown that ends on 14 April
- 27. Pakistan, U.K.: PIA restores some international flights amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 28. **Pakistan:** PIA suspends flight operations from Karachi after pilots quarantined amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 29. **Sri Lanka:** Aviation authority announces all international airports to remain closed for international inbound passenger flights until further notice
- 30. Malaysia: International flights to Penang airport canceled because of COVID-19
- 31. **Bangladesh:** Biman Bangladesh Airlines cancels all international, domestic flights until 14 April because of COVID-19

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

- 32. **Guyana:** Civil Aviation Authority suspends all domestic flights to areas near border to curb spread of COVID-19
- 33. **Jamaica:** Government extends closure of borders, ban of incoming passenger flights for 14 days because of COVID-19
- 34. Ecuador: Government increases movement restrictions in some areas due to spread of COVID-19
- 35. Guatemala: Government bans internal travel from 5-12 April

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

- 36. Equatorial Guinea: U.S. Embassy reports on travel restrictions implemented by government
- 37. **Tunisia:** U.S. Embassy reports on personal movement restrictions implemented to prevent spread of COVID-19
- 38. **Zambia:** U.S. Embassy reports government institutes mandatory quarantine and monitoring of persons entering country amid COVID-19 concerns

- Gambia: Government extends state of public emergency for 45 days to contain spread of COVID-19
- 40. United Arab Emirates: Dubai imposes two-week lockdown to contain spread of COVID-19
- 41. **Saudi Arabia:** Authorities announce lockdown, partial curfew in several areas of Jeddah because
- 42. Algeria: Country will extend curfews from 5 April because of COVID-19
- Kenya: Government extends suspension of international flights by another 30 days because of COVID-19

NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

44. **Marshall Islands:** U.S. Embassy reports on suspension of incoming international travelers through 5 May

AIRLINES:

- 45. **U.K.:** Aurigny suspends all its remaining flights to London Gatwick Airport until at least end of May after COVID-19 causes lack of demand
- 46. Mexico, U.S.: Aeromexico, Interjet and Volaris cancel flights to, from San Antonio International Airport because of COVID-19
- 47. U.S.: United Airlines reduces number of flights to, from Newark and LaGuardia airports in New York because of COVID-19
- 48. India: Air Deccan ceases operations until further notice amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 49. **U.K**.: All easyJet flights canceled throughout April amid COVID-19 pandemic; airline to operate repatriation flights only
- 50. U.S.: American Airlines reduces daily flights into three New York airports to limit exposure of staff to COVID-19
- 51. Japan, U.K.: British Airways to suspend direct flights between London and Tokyo after 8 April amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 52. Vietnam: Vietnam Airlines to limit number of passengers on flights to Ho Chi Minh City until 15 April amid COVID-19 pandemic
- 53. **U.K.: Aurigny** suspends all its remaining flights to London Gatwick Airport until at least end of May after COVID-19 causes lack of demand
