ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent bans in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

1. **Zimbabwe: Fastjet** Zimbabwe plans to restart flights on 21 April
2. **Iceland:** U.S. Embassy reports about limited commercial flights out of country during COVID-19 outbreak
3. **Argentina:** U.S. Embassy reports about possible repatriation flights for Americans
4. **Peru:** U.S. Embassy reports about repatriation flights on 8, 9 April because of COVID-19
5. **Bulgaria:** U.S. Embassy reports international commercial flights still available amid COVID-19 outbreak
6. **Liberia:** U.S. Embassy reports there is limited availability on charter flight for U.S. citizens on 8 April for COVID-19
7. **Equatorial Guinea:** U.S. Embassy reports seats are still available on repatriation flight for Americans on 8 April
8. **Lithuania:** U.S. Embassy reports about repatriation flights for Americans because of COVID-19 outbreak
9. **U.K.:** U.S. Embassy reports service limited at London Heathrow Airport because of COVID-19
10. **Australia:** U.S. Embassy reports there are still international commercial flights amid COVID-19 outbreak
11. **Saudi Arabia:** U.S. Embassy reports Saudia Airlines will offer limited commercial flights amid COVID-19 outbreak

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Macedonia:** U.S. Embassy reports expanded curfew in, near Kumanovo; nationwide restrictions continue because of COVID-19
2. **Latvia:** Government extends state of emergency until 12 May because of COVID-19
3. **Czech Republic:** State of emergency extended until 30 April because of COVID-19
4. **Denmark:** U.S. Embassy reports border closure extension through 10 May, other restrictions continue amid COVID-19 concerns
5. **Bulgaria:** U.S. Embassy reports country has banned admission to third-country nationals, including U.S. citizens because of COVID-19
6. **Czech Republic:** U.S. Embassy reports about availability of commercial flights amid COVID-19 outbreak; continue to decrease

ASIAN / AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

7. **Nepal:** Suspension of international flights extended until 30 April because of COVID-19
8. **Thailand:** U.S. Embassy reports on closure of Phuket International Airport amid COVID-19 concerns; other restrictions continue
9. **Israel:** Update: Government announces complete lockdown from 7 April, curfew from 8 April because of COVID-19
10. **Azerbaijan:** U.S. Embassy provides new information regarding suspension of flights through 20 April amid COVID-19 concerns; government implements stricter rules
11. **Japan:** Prime minister declares state of emergency until 6 May in Tokyo and other areas in response to COVID-19 outbreak
12. **Hong Kong:** U.S. Embassy reports government implements inbound travel restrictions because of COVID-19
13. **India:** Mumbai to extend COVID-19 lockdown measures until at least 30 April
14. **Philippines:** Country's airlines extend flight cancellations through 30 April because of COVID-19

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

15. **Honduras:** U.S. Embassy reports guidance on government's quarantine measure; curfew continues because of COVID-19
16. **El Salvador:** Country extends nationwide quarantine until 5 May amid COVID-19 outbreak
17. **Chile:** U.S. Embassy reports about ongoing measures to reduce spread of COVID-19

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

18. **Senegal:** Country extends state of emergency for 30 days because of COVID-19
19. **Chad:** U.S. Embassy reports repatriation flight for Americans scheduled on 9 April because of COVID-19
20. **Benin:** U.S. Embassy reports about repatriation flights, mask requirements due to COVID-19

NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

21. **Bahamas:** U.S. Embassy reports nationwide lockdown, limited commercial and charter airline flights still available to U.S. amid COVID-19 concerns

22. **Jamaica:** U.S. Embassy reports on extension of closure for incoming travels amid COVID-19 concerns, provides list of JetBlue flights to U.S. on 11 April
23. **Canada:** Edmonton International Airport closes parts of terminal because of COVID-19
24. **U.S.:** New Jersey governor to extend public health emergency by 30 days because of COVID-19
25. **U.S.:** California's Hollywood Burbank Airport closes one terminal because of lack demand amid the COVID-19 outbreak

AIRLINES:

26. **Kenya: Jambojet** will temporarily suspend all its operations until 30 April because of COVID-19
27. **U.S.: Elite Airways** cancels all April flights to, from Vero Beach Regional Airport because of COVID-19
28. **Senegal: Air Senegal** extends scheduled service suspension until 16 May because of COVID-19
29. **U.K.: Jet2** confirms all flights, package holidays before 17 June will be canceled because of COVID-19
30. **Nicaragua:** U.S. Embassy reports **Aeromexico** will suspend service to Managua starting 9 April amid COVID-19 concerns, advises U.S. nationals to leave or prepare to stay indefinitely
31. **U.S.: Southwest Airlines** will cut half of its flights in June because of COVID-19
32. **U.S.: United Airlines** temporarily reduces flights in, out of Los Angeles and San Francisco airports because of COVID-19
33. **Pakistan: PIA** resumes flight operations as pilots end strike after agreement for safety measures due to COVID-19 outbreak
34. **U.S.: Alaska-based RavnAir Group** files for bankruptcy, halts all flights because of economic fallout from COVID-19 pandemic
