ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Poland:** Update: Government may reopen borders 15 June, lift remaining COVID-19 restrictions 1 July
2. **Bulgaria, Greece, Serbia:** Update: Bulgarian government agrees with Greece, Serbia to ease some travel restrictions from 1 June
3. **Portugal:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy updates its information on restrictions and other COVID-19 measures: The Government of Portugal decreed a mandatory use of protective masks in crowded, closed spaces such as public transportation, schools, supermarkets and stores.
4. **Europe, Israel:** Update: **Greek** government will reopen borders for tourists from Schengen area and Israel on or before 1 July
5. **Albania:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports museums, libraries are now open, outdoor exercise is permitted amid COVID-19 outbreak

ASIAN /AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

6. **Kyrgyz Republic:** Update: Government will lift most of remaining COVID-19 restrictions during the next few days, reopening public transportation and hotels
7. **Singapore:** Update: Government will gradually reopen borders

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

8. **Uganda:** Update: President will start easing COVID-19 lockdown measures starting 2 June

AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

9. **Cuba:** Government plans to reopen airports on 7 July after suspension because of COVID-19

AIRLINES:

10. **Global:** Update: **Etihad Airways** adds further flights in May and June to, from Abu Dhabi
11. **Australia:** Update: **Qantas** will resume regular flights from 12 June, announces details of 'Fly Well' program
12. **Canada:** Update: **Air Canada** plans to resume flights between Fort St. John and Vancouver on 22 June
13. **South Korea:** Update: **Jeju Air** plans to resume operations in July
14. **Canada, Mexico, U.S.:** Update: U.S. government extends ban on nonessential travel with Canada and Mexico shared borders through 22 June
15. **Bosnia and Herzegovina, Germany:** Update: **Eurowings** to resume Bosnia and Herzegovina service from June

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

16. **Moldova:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports public health emergency will continue through 30 June, border and Chisinau airport are still closed
17. **China:** Update: Authorities seal off Shulan after fresh COVID-19 outbreak
18. **Egypt:** Update: Government extends halt to all international passenger flights until further notice because of COVID-19
19. **Lebanon:** Update: Government extends state of emergency until 7 June because of COVID-19
20. **Colombia:** Update: Mandatory quarantine extended until 31 May because of COVID-19
21. **Brazil, Colombia, Venezuela:** Update: New curfews imposed in several border towns because of COVID-19
22. **El Salvador:** Update: Government extends lockdown until 6 June because of COVID-19

AIRLINES:

23. **Thailand:** Update: Thai Airways International extends suspension of flights until 30 June because of COVID-19

24. **Brazil, Spain: Globalia** suspends plans to operate domestic flights in Brazil amid COVID-19 outbreak
