ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Poland:** U.S. Embassy updates its information on COVID-19 restrictions
2. **Albania, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia:** Albanian tourism will resume from 1 June, government will reopen some land borders for its nationals
3. **Hungary:** Government expects to end state of emergency on 20 June

ASIAN /AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

4. **India:** Cancellations continue for second day at several airports; passenger flights resume in Andhra Pradesh
5. **Hong Kong:** Hong Kong International Airport will gradually resume service from 1 June
6. **Sri Lanka:** Authorities relax curfew in Colombo from 26 May

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

7. **Panama:** Government to relax some COVID-19 measures beginning 1 June

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

8. **Nigeria:** Governor of Rivers State cancels lockdown, imposes curfew from 2 June
9. **Saudi Arabia:** Domestic flights to resume following suspension of flights because of COVID-19

AIRLINES:

10. Europe, Israel: **Blue Air** announces reopening of scheduled flights in early July to several destinations
11. South Africa: **South African Airways** aims to resume some domestic flights from mid-June;

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

1. **Guinea-Bissau:** President extends state of emergency until 10 June because of COVID-19 outbreak
2. **Argentina:** U.S. Embassy reports national quarantine extended through 7 June because of COVID-19

AIRLINES:

3. Canada: **Porter Airlines** extends suspension of flights until 29 July
4. South Africa: **South African Airways** cancellations of regional, intercontinental flights extended until end of June
