## ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

#### EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- **Europe:** Update: Odessa airport resumes flights to Berlin, Budapest, Minsk
- **Georgia:** Update: Railway services resume
- **Finland:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports new border restrictions are in effect from 15 June
- **Spain:** Update: U.K. Embassy reportedly confirms British nationals will be allowed to travel to Spain from 21 June
- **Russia, Turkmenistan:** Authorities to lift restrictions on several flights between countries

#### AFRICA:

- **Egypt:** Update: Government will reopen all airports for scheduled international traffic on 1 July
- **Algeria:** Update: Government eases curfew but land, sea borders remain closed
- **Botswana:** Update: Government lifts COVID-19 lockdown in Gaborone, surrounding areas

#### MIDDLE EAST:

- **Iran, Turkey:** Update: Flights between countries will likely resume on 20 June
- **United Arab Emirates:** Update: Government to allow citizens, residents to travel to specific destinations as of 23 June

#### AMERICAS:

- **Mexico:** Update: Mexico City's mayor to begin gradual exit from COVID-19 lockdown on 15 June
- **Bermuda:** Update: International commercial flights expected to resume from 1 July
- **El Salvador:** Update: Government ends COVID-19 lockdown; airports to reopen 6 August

### ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Japan, Vietnam:** Update: Government to ease travel restrictions starting with flights to Vietnam

### AIRLINES:

- **Malaysia:** Update: **AirAsia** to resume all domestic flights from July
- **China, U.S.:** Update: **Delta Air Lines** to resume passenger flights to Shanghai next week
- **Canada, Mexico, U.S.:** Update: **WestJet** releases updated flight schedule for July with new destinations
- **China, New Zealand:** Update: **Air New Zealand** announces flights to China amid ongoing COVID-19 concerns

## Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

- **China:** Update: Beijing government reintroduces strict lockdown measures after fresh cluster of COVID-19 cases emerge
- **India:** Government declares total lockdown in, near Chennai from 19-30 June as COVID-19 cases surge
- **Myanmar:** Update: Government announces restrictions on visas, international flights and public gatherings extended through 30 June
- **Venezuela:** Update: Government extends ban on commercial flights until 12 July because of COVID-19
- **Pakistan:** Update: Authorities to reimpose lockdowns in several cities from 15 June to stem COVID-19 spread
- **United Arab Emirates:** Update: Abu Dhabi government extends ban on movement in, out of emirate and cities by one more week
- **Philippines:** Update: Partial COVID-19 restrictions to remain in Manila; lockdown reinstated in Cebu City
- **Canada:** Manitoba government extends state of emergency for 30 days to reduce spread of COVID-19
- **Uzbekistan:** Update: Authorities extends COVID-19 quarantine until 1 August
- **China:** Update: Shanghai government introduces 14-day quarantine for those entering the city from high-risk COVID-19 areas following cluster outbreak in Beijing
