The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and guarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

• **Indonesia:** Update: First phase of Bali's reopening set to begin 9 July; domestic tourism will return by end of month

- Kenya: Update: Jambojet set to resume flights to local destinations from 15 July
- Global: Update: United Airlines plans to resume several routes to Asian, European, Latin American cities in August
- Bangladesh, United Arab Emirates: Update: Biman Bangladesh Airlines to resume commercial flights to United Arab Emirates from 9 July
- Europe: Update: Blue Air resumes flights to Belgium, Greece, Italy, Spain and U.K.
- France, Ukraine: Update: Air France to resume flights to Ukraine from 13 July

- **New Zealand, United Arab Emirates**: Update: Emirates suspends new bookings of flights to Auckland for the next three weeks
- **Uzbekistan**: Update: Government to impose fresh lockdown restrictions 10 July-1 August to curb spread of COVID-19
