## ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

#### EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- No updates

#### AFRICA:

- **Morocco:** Update: Government will start gradually reopening air and maritime borders next week
- **Sudan:** Update: Authorities partially open Khartoum international airport to flights from Egypt, Turkey and United Arab Emirates
- **Djibouti:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports Djibouti's Ambouli International Airport will open to incoming, outgoing flights on 17 July; all passengers will be tested for COVID-19

#### MIDDLE EAST:

- No updates

#### AMERICAS:

- No updates

### ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Australia:** Update: Queensland will allow people from all states and territories to enter, except those from Victoria, from 10 July
- Asia, Australia, New Zealand: Update: **Japan** looks to reopen business travel with more countries

### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Israel, Turkey, London: Update: **Pegasus flights** between London and Tel Aviv via Istanbul resume
- Belgium, France, Netherlands, U.K.: Update: **Eurostar** will resume some services

### Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

- **Bangladesh, Italy:** Update: Italian government bars entry to passengers from Bangladesh until 5 October
- **Bangladesh:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports passengers departing from Dhaka on Emirates will need COVID-19 test results at time of check-in
- **Morocco:** Update: Government extends COVID-19 emergency decree until 10 August
- **Italy:** Update: Authorities ban entry from 13 countries because of COVID-19 threat

### AIRLINES

- France: Update: **LEVEL France** will close down in coming weeks
- Pakistan, U.S.: Department of Transportation revokes permission for Pakistan International Airlines to operate charter flights to U.S. because of pilot concerns
