ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and guarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- Austria, Italy: Update: Austrian authorities will lift travel warning for Lombardy region.
- Europe: <u>Update</u>: Greece, Malta, Norway reopen to U.K. nationals.
- Spain, U.K.: Flights to Spain from Teesside Airport to resume on 14 August.

AFRICA:

- Nigeria: <u>Update</u>: All remaining airports will reopen for commercial operations in one week.
- Senegal: <u>Update</u>: Airspace reopens with restrictions.

MIDDLE EAST:

AMERICAS:

No updates

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- Pakistan, United Arab Emirates: <u>Update</u>: Update: Etihad Airways resumes flights between countries.
- Russia: Update: Authorities reopen borders for international tourism; quarantine requirements lifted.

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Europe: Update: **Jet2** resumes flights; full list of destinations released.
- Global: <u>Update</u>: **Qatar Airways**, **SriLankan Airlines**, **Emirates**, **Etihad** schedule flights to Maldives in July as country resumes international travel; more airlines plan to resume flights from August.
- Hungary, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates: <u>Update</u>: **Wizz Air** to resume flights between Ukraine and the United Arab Emirates in October.
- Kuwait: Jazeera Airways to resume flights to 20 destinations in August.
- Canada, Switzerland: Update: Swiss International Air Lines resumes flights between Montreal and Zurich.
- Netherlands, Romania: Update: **Blue Air** to operate daily flights between Bucharest and Amsterdam from 4 September.

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES:

- Europe: <u>Update</u>: **Wizz Air** temporarily suspends some flights to several European cities because of low demand, COVID-19 restrictions.
- Ireland: <u>Update</u>: **Aer Lingus** plans to cut some European flights from 20 July because of quarantine restriction on EU visitors.
- Thailand: Update: Thai Airways not expected to resume flights until September at earliest.
- Egypt, Europe: Update: Austrian Airlines cancels several flights as list of landing bans extended.

Areas & Airpoirts:

- **Rwanda**: Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports lockdown for at least 15 days in Nyamagabe and Nyamasheke districts.
- **Vanuatu**: Government extends state of emergency until end of year because of COVID-19, recent destruction caused by storm.
- China, Thailand: China's civil aviation authorities temporarily suspend two Thailand flights after COVID-19 cases.
- Philippines: <u>Update</u>: Manila government extends partial restrictions in Manila for two weeks.
- Poland: Update: Government extends ban on international flights to 28 July.
- **Belgium**: <u>Update</u>: Brussels Airlines to postpone extension of its flight schedule by one week in August because of financial situation.
- Moldova: <u>Security Message</u>: U.S. Embassy reports public health emergency will continue until 31 July.
- **Chile**: <u>Security Message</u>: U.S. Embassy reports additional changes to quarantine measures to limit spread of COVID-19.
