ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- **France:** National rail operator SNCF to offer temperature tests to passengers prior to boarding

AFRICA:

- **South Africa:** Three additional domestic airports reopen from 21 July
- **Rwanda:** Kigali International Airport to reopen on 1 August

MIDDLE EAST:

- No updates.

AMERICAS:

- **Bermuda:** Update: Authorities expected to lift COVID-19 curfew on 20 July

- **St Vincent & Grenadines, U.S.:** St Vincent and Grenadines' government may ban flights from the U.S. after COVID-19 cases

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **China, Finland:** Finnair will resume flights between Helsinki and Shanghai from 23 July
- **Nepal:** Government to resume international, domestic flights from 17 August

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **U.K.:** Virgin Atlantic resumes passenger flights
- **India:** Air India opens bookings for international flights to the U.S. from 22 July

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES:

- **Japan, New Caledonia:** AirCalin postpones Osaka service resumption until March 2021 because of COVID-19
- **Croatia, United Arab Emirates:** Emirates cancels Zagreb service for 2020

Areas & Airports:

- **El Salvador:** President postpones again second phase of economic reopening because of COVID-19-related concerns
- **China:** Authorities tighten restrictions in Urumqi because of spike in COVID-19 cases
- **India:** Seven-day lockdown imposed in some areas of Chhattisgarh from 22 July because of COVID-19 cases
- **Israel:** Authorities extend ban of foreigners entry until at least 1 September
- **Dominican Republic :**Government declares state of emergency for 45 days because of COVID-19
- **Honduras:** U.S. Embassy reports national curfew extended until 26 July
- **Global: Passengers of China** flights required to provide negative COVID-19 test results prior to boarding
