# ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

## Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- Sri Lanka: Update: Transport services resume in Western Province after curfew lifted
- Libya: Flights to all airports in southern region resume
- U.S.: Some flights to South America resume at Orlando International Airport
- Bahamas: Update: Government relaxes some COVID-19 curbs for New Providence and Abaco, increases restrictions for mainland Eleuthera
- Hong Kong, Singapore: Update: Travel bubble between countries to begin 22 November
- Australia: Avalon Airport will resume flights from 18 December

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- South Africa: Kulula plans to resume operations from 1 December
- Botswana, South Africa: Airlink will resume Gaborone flights on 16 November, possibly Kasane and Maun services from 30 November
- Caribbean, U.S.: Update: Bahamasair will resume some international flights from 15 November
- Hong Kong, Russia: Aeroflot will resume flights to Hong Kong from 19 November
- Israel, Serbia: Update: El Al will maintain service between Tel Aviv and Belgrade; Israir and Arkia tentatively scheduled to restart next month, Air Serbia resumes flights between the two cities in Spring 2021
- Israel, Seychelles: Update: Air Seychelles will resume flights to Tel Aviv from 18 November
- Canada, St. Lucia, U.S.: Update: **American Airlines**, **JetBlue**, **United Airlines** resume flights to St. Lucia

### Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- **Sweden**: Update: Swedish authorities extend nonessential travel warning for non-EU countries until 2021
- U.K.: Update: Cornwall Airport Newquay closes, suspends all flights because of COVID-19 restrictions
- Italy: Update: Government increases COVID-19 restrictions in Tuscany and four other regions
- **Lebanon**: Update: Government will impose full lockdown from 14-30 November because of COVID-19; airport, sea port, land borders will remain open
- Bahamas: Update: Government relaxes some COVID-19 curbs for New Providence and Abaco, increases restrictions for mainland Eleuthera
- Germany: Berlin Tegel Airport closes; all air traffic in capital region will be concentrated at Berlin Brandenburg Airport
- New Caledonia: Government extends travel restrictions in, out of country until end of July 2021 because of COVID-19 pandemic
- Poland: Government bans passenger flights to 10 countries as it tightens COVID-19 restrictions
- Ukraine: Government to impose weekend lockdown to curb spread of COVID-19

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- Europe: Update: Lufthansa suspends flights to Sarajevo and Zagreb on 1 December; services may resume 2021 summer season.
- Kazakhstan, Turkey: Air Astana cancels some flights to Istanbul from 9 November
- Canada: Update: Porter Airlines extends suspension of flights until 11 February
- U.K.: Update: British Airways suspends flights between Inverness, London Heathrow because of COVID-19 lockdown in England
- New Zealand: Update: Air New Zealand extends suspension of inbound bookings until 14 December
- Finland, Ireland: TUI Airways cancels all flights to Lapland this year because of COVID-19
