ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- **Sweden, U.K.:** Update: Swedish government lifts advisory against travel to U.K.
- **Ireland:** Update: Government sets new rules for quarantine-free travel

AFRICA:

- **Morocco:** Update: Government reopens borders to 67 visa-exempt countries with some restrictions
- **Zimbabwe:** Update: Government further extends operating hours for businesses as it gradually reopens economy amid COVID-19 pandemic. Government lifts ban on inter-city travel as it eases COVID-19 restrictions
- **Nigeria:** Update: Government reopens all airports for domestic flights

MIDDLE EAST:

- **Israel:** Update: Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport will remain open during forthcoming national lockdown

AMERICAS:

- **St. Kitts and Nevis:** Update: Government will begin reopening borders in October

- **Panama:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports changes to movement restrictions begin 14 September

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Hong Kong:** Update: Government to reopen bars, pools and theme parks from 18 September following mass COVID-19 testing program
- **Thailand:** Update: Government plans to reopen country to tourists in October
- **Nepal:** Update: Domestic flights, long-distance bus services to resume from 21 September
- **Asia:** Update: Flights from Vietnam to several Asian countries to resume from 18 September

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Africa:** Update: **Kenya Airways** will resume commercial passenger flights to Ghana, Liberia, Sierra Leone
- **Indonesia, Pakistan, Turkey:** **Lion Air** will operate flights to Pakistan amid bilateral agreement; **Turkish Airlines** also resumes flights
- **Global:** Update: **Several airlines** resume flights to **Yerevan**
- **Nigeria, Rwanda:** Update: **RwandAir** will resume flights to Lagos on 18 September

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Croatia:** **Croatia Airlines** cancels some international flights between 21-30 September

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Mongolia:** Update: Borders remain closed, commercial international flights canceled as government extends state of readiness because of COVID-19
- **Equatorial Guinea:** Official Travel Advice: U.K. warns against nonessential travel, reports COVID-19 concerns
- **China, Hong Kong:** Official Travel Advice: U.S. advises 'reconsider travel', reports COVID-19 concerns
- **Israel:** Update: Public transport will be affected as government imposes three-week lockdown from 18 September; other restrictions reported
- **Venezuela:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports airspace restrictions extended to 12 October
- **Peru:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports Lima-Miami repatriation flight available 17 September
- **Honduras:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports national curfew extended through 20 September
- **Jordan:** Government orders closure of restaurants, mosques and schools because of increase in COVID-19 infections
- **Vietnam:** Update: Suspension of international flights continues as officials clarify COVID-19 plan
- **Denmark:** Government limits opening hours for restaurants, bars and cafes in Copenhagen after rise in new COVID-19 infections
- **Greece:** Authorities tighten COVID-19 restrictions in Athens area
- **Cuba:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy updates its information on COVID-19 restrictions in Havana
- **Spain:** Government to impose lockdowns in some areas of Madrid because of increase in COVID-19 cases
