ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines <u>status may change at any given time</u> without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

 Europe: Update: Hungary's government opens borders to three nearby countries as COVID-19 lockdown begins

AFRICA:

- **Nigeria**: Enugu airport reopens for domestic flights following renovation; international services set to resume 5 September.
- **Ghana**: Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports opening of Accra's Kotoka International Airport, advises U.S. nationals about scheduling emergency passport service appointments.

MIDDLE EAST:

AMERICAS:

 Guatemala: Update: Guatemala City's La Aurora International Airport expected to reopen to commercial flights on 18 September

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Singapore:** the port of Singapore introduced some enhancements for crew changes. Attached to this e-mail you will find the latest regulations regarding crew changes in Singapore.
- **Philippines**: Update: Government further eases COVID-19 restrictions in Manila, places city of Iligan under minor lockdown following rise in infections
- Bhutan: Update: Government begins relaxation of nationwide lockdown
- Japan: Japan will reopen its borders to Taiwanese business travelers on 8 September

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

• Israel, U.K., U.S.: Update: Virgin Atlantic will also resume flying to Tel Aviv and Atlanta in September as travel restrictions ease

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Europe: Update: Ryanair reportedly cancels flights to, from Ukraine for 15-29 September
- France, Serbia: Air France to suspend Paris-Belgrade services from 24 October until 28 March amid COVID-19 restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Greece: Update: Civil aviation authority extends travel ban and restrictions to several countries because of COVID-19
- Belize: Update: Operations at Philip Goldson International Airport will remain suspended until 1 October
- Indonesia: Update: Bali will remain closed for international tourists until end of year
- Cuba: Update: Curfew imposed in Havana as COVID-19 cases rise
