### ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

#### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Australia, New Zealand:** Update: Australia authorities will resume one-way travel bubble with New Zealand on 21 February
- **New Zealand:** Update: Authorities further ease COVID-19 restrictions in Auckland from midnight on 22 February

##### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Netherlands, South Africa, South America, UK:** KLM reopens flights for all eligible passengers from South Africa, Panama and South America to Amsterdam, special procedure with eligibility checks applies. Eligible passengers are: Marine crew, Dutch nationals, airline crew and medical staff.
- **France, Portugal:** Air France to resume flights between Faro and Paris from 17 April amid COVID-19 pandemic

#### Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **North America:** Update: U.S. government extends closure of land borders with Canada, Mexico to nonessential travel until at least 21 March because of COVID-19
- **Denmark, Germany:** Denmark temporarily closes some borders with Germany because of spike in COVID-19 cases
- **Canada:** Update: Toronto extends COVID-19 lockdown until 8 March
- **Turkey, U.K.:** Flights from Istanbul to Edinburgh Airport canceled because of COVID-19 hotel quarantine policy
- **Iran, Iraq:** Iranian authorities close several crossing points with Iraq to stem spread of COVID-19 variant

- **Kuwait:** Update: Entry ban on non-Kuwaiti citizens extended until further notice because of COVID-19
- **Greece:** Update: Greek government extends incoming flight restrictions and obligatory self-isolation on international arrivals until 8 March
