ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

AMERICAS:

- Europe, Uruguay: Update: **Uruguay** government will reopen borders for tourism to European Union nationals
- **Panama:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports COVID-19 movement restrictions will be replaced by curfew on 24 August

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Nepal:** Update: Regular international flights to resume from 1 September; negative COVID-19 test, one-week hotel quarantine required
- **Philippines:** Update: Philippine Airlines increases number of domestic flights to Mindanao from 25 August as COVID-19 restrictions ease

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Nigeria, U.K.: Update: **Virgin Atlantic** to resume flights between **Lagos and London** on 10 September

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Portugal, U.K.:** Update: **Jet2** resumes flights to Faro from 24 August after quarantine restrictions for arrivals from Portugal lifted
- Europe: Update: **Lufthansa** postpones plans of resuming **Frankfurt-Zagreb, Munich-Ljubljana** flights

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Morocco:** Update: Tightened measures implemented in Casablanca, Marrakesh as COVID-19 infections spike; partial lockdowns ordered in Rabat, Tangiers
- **Poland:** Update: Government plans to extend flight ban to 63 countries from 26 August
- **Honduras:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports national curfew extended until 6 September
- **Europe, Israel:** Update: Several airlines cancel plans to resume **Ljubljana** flights
- **New Zealand:** Update: Government extends COVID-19 lockdown in Auckland through 30 August
- **Philippines:** Authorities suspend all commercial flights at **General Santos International Airport** from 24 August following surge in COVID-19 infections
- **Indonesia:** Update: **Bali** postpones plans to reopen to international tourists from 11 September
