ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- **Egypt, Russia:** Update: Civil aviation authority approves resumption of flights between Cairo and Moscow

AFRICA:

- **Mozambique:** Update: International flights will be allowed from 7 September as government lifts state of emergency

MIDDLE EAST:

- **Jordan:** Update: Transport authorities announce list of countries for resuming flights

AMERICAS:

- **No update**

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Vietnam:** Update: Vietnam Airlines flights to, from Da Nang restart 7 September amid COVID-19 pandemic

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Jordan, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Emirates** to resume flights between Dubai and Amman from 8 September
- **India, Maldives:** Update: **Maldivian** to resume flights between Male and Trivandrum on 10 September
- **Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana, United Arab Emirates:** **Emirates** will resume flights to Cote d'Ivoire and Ghana starting 6 September amid COVID-19 pandemic
- **Nigeria, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Emirates** resumes flights to Nigerian cities from 7 September
- **China, Finland:** **Finnair** will resume services between Helsinki and Nanjing from 11 September
- **Europe:** Update: **AirBaltic** resumes flights from Riga to Amsterdam, Brussels, Dublin, Gothenburg, Lisbon, Prague, Reykjavik, Vienna and Zurich

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Europe: Update: **Jet2** cancels its flights to mainland Spain, Dubrovnik, Split, Pula until 31 October
- Cyprus, Greece: **Blue Air** cancels its flights between Larnaca and Athens, Thessaloniki from mid-September until end of March 2021
- Europe: Update: **EasyJet** temporarily suspends some flights to, from Slovenia, Serbia, Kosovo, Germany, Switzerland, U.K.
- **Europe:** Update: **AirBaltic** flights to Spain, Andorra, and Luxembourg temporarily banned
