### ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

#### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Global:** Update: **Lebanese** government eases restrictions on travelers from several countries
- **India:** Update: Several states gradually start easing COVID-19-related restrictions and curbs
- **Northern Marianas, South Korea:** Update: Countries sign quarantine-free travel agreement as stricter COVID-19 restrictions begin in Seoul
- **Bangladesh:** Update: Public transport will resume on limited scale as COVID-19 restrictions relaxed from 15-22 July
- **Albania, Sweden:** Swedish authorities ease COVID-19 restrictions for travelers from Albania
- **St. Kitts and Nevis:** Government eases restrictions for most international air travelers
- **Bangladesh:** Update: Government allows resumption of flight operations to all domestic destinations for eight days from 15 July

##### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- No updates.

#### Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Denmark:** Update: Danish government updates travel rules amid COVID-19 pandemic, imposes new entry restrictions on travelers from Slovakia, several regions of Spain
- **South Africa:** Update: Government extends Level 4 lockdown until 25 July; some restrictions will be eased
- **Algeria:** Government extends lockdown for 21 days because of COVID-19

- **Tunisia:** Authorities extend COVID-19 lockdown in Kasserine by one week
- **India:** Arunachal Pradesh government imposes total lockdown in Itanagar until 20 July because of COVID-19
- **France:** Government to increase border checks, require 'health passport' for long-distance train, bus travel and introduce other measures to stem increase in COVID-19 cases
- **Europe:** Update: **French** authorities announce stricter restrictions on unvaccinated travelers from Portugal, Spain and U.K.
- **Global: Pakistan's** civil aviation authority extends travel restrictions on international inbound passengers from 26 countries until 31 July
- **Czech Republic:** Update: Czech authorities add Cyprus, Balearic Islands and Portugal to red list of COVID-19 countries
- **Australia:** Western Australia authorities tighten border with New South Wales because of COVID-19
- **Bahrain:** Update: Aviation authority will ban entry from 16 new countries because of COVID-19
- **Australia:** Update: Authorities in Sydney extend COVID-19 lockdown for at least 14 days
- **Guatemala:** Government declares state of emergency, tightens COVID-19 restrictions as cases surge
- **Asia, Middle East:** Update: **Philippines** government extends ban on inbound travel from several countries until 31 July to prevent spread of COVID-19 variant
- **Indonesia, Philippines:** Philippines government to ban entry of travelers from Indonesia 16-31 July to prevent spread of COVID-19 Delta variant
- **Greece:** Government to require vaccination against COVID-19 at indoor restaurants, bars and cafes
- **Spain:** Catalonia authorities impose limits on gatherings, earlier closing times to curb spread of COVID-19
- **Peru:** Government extends state of emergency until end of August because of COVID-19

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- **Thailand:** Update: **Bangkok Airways** cancels some domestic flights between 13-31 July because of COVID-19 travel restrictions
- **Argentina, Brazil, Chile:** Update: **LATAM Airlines** cancels, limits passengers on some flights
- **South Africa:** Update: **Comair** extends suspension of all scheduled Kulula, British Airways flights until end of August because of COVID-19 lockdown
- **Cape Verde:** Update: **Cabo Verde Airlines** cancels all flights after returning to state control
