ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

- No updates

AFRICA:

- **Nigeria:** Update: Curfew imposed on Lagos expected to be relaxed on 23 October.

MIDDLE EAST:

- No updates.

AMERICAS:

- Global: Update: **Peru** will resume international flights to 24 destinations in 10 countries in the Americas.

ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Thailand:** Government will gradually open borders to foreign tourists.

- **Philippines:** Update: Government to allow entry of foreign investors starting 1 November

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Europe: **Blue Air** will resume flights from Cluj-Napoca to several European destinations from March 2021.
- Kuwait, Saudi Arabia: Update: **Kuwait Airways** resumes flights to Riyadh, Jeddah and Dammam from 25 October.
- Israel, Serbia: Update: **El Al Israel Airlines** will launch flights between Tel Aviv and Belgrade starting 1 November.
- Germany, India: Update: **Lufthansa** resumes flights between countries after three-week suspension.
- Panama, Turkey: **Turkish Airlines** to resume Istanbul-Tocumen flights from 1 November.
- Caribbean, U.K.: **Virgin Atlantic** will resume flights from London to Antigua and Grenada from 26 October; services continue to other islands.

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Belarus, Kazakhstan: Update: **Belavia** cancels all flights between Minsk, Almaty scheduled from 26 October 2020 until 27 March 2021 following decision of Kazakhstan authorities.
- Nigeria: Update: **Arik Air** extends cancellation of flight operations because of curfew in Lagos State, other parts of country.

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Burkina Faso:** Official Travel Advice: U.S. warns against travel because of health, safety and security risks.
- **Europe:** Update: German government issues travel warnings for Ireland, Poland, Switzerland and most of Austria in attempt to curb spread of COVID-19.
- **Panama:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports about changes to COVID-19 restrictions.
- **Greece:** Authorities will impose lockdown in Kastoria from 23 October to contain spread of COVID-19.
- **Italy:** Government will impose nightly curfew from 23 October in Lazio region, including Rome, due to COVID-19 resurgence.
- **Spain:** Update: Madrid, other areas consider nighttime curfew to slow spread of COVID-19; Aragon and La Rioja announce new travel restrictions.
- **Europe, United Arab Emirates:** Update: Air Astana will cut a number of flights because of government orders.
- **Portugal:** Partial lockdown imposed on three northern municipalities; only essential activities allowed.
- **Czech Republic:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy updates its information on COVID-19 restrictions; free movement will be restricted to essential tasks.
- **Slovakia:** Update: Partial lockdown to be imposed from 24 October to 1 November to halt spread of COVID-19.
- **Chile:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy updates its information on COVID-19 quarantine measures.
- **Uruguay:** Government to close borders during summer season due to COVID-19 concerns.
