ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Global**: Update: Russian authorities to allow regular air service with Bahrain, Dominican Republic, Moldova from 9 August; flights to Czech Republic, France will resume from 28 July.
- **Chile**: Update: Country to open borders to nationals and foreign residents that have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 on 26 July.
- Egypt, Russia: Update: Flights between Moscow and Hurghada, Sharm El-Sheikh will resume on 9 August.

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Bermuda, Canada: Air Canada will resume direct flights between Bermuda and Toronto from 6 August.
- India: Update: Delhi Metro services restart full capacity seating on 26 July as COVID-19 pandemic subsides.

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Italy: Update: Government extends COVID-19 state of emergency until end of the year.
- **Europe**: Update: Unvaccinated travelers to Germany arriving from Spain, Netherlands will have to quarantine for at least five days after countries declared high risk.
- Vietnam: Update: Government to extend strict COVID-19 lockdown in Ho Chi Minh City until 1 August.
- Croatia, Montenegro: Update: COVID-19 rules tightened in preparation for tourist season.
- India: Update: Mizoram government extends COVID-19 lockdown in Aizawl until 31 July.
- Africa, India, South America, Spain: Update: Spanish government to introduce COVID-19 quarantine for travelers from several countries from 27 July; existing travel restrictions remain.
- Cambodia: Update: Government extends COVID-19 lockdown in Phnom Penh until 6 Augus.t

- South Korea: Update: Government to tighten COVID-19 social distancing restrictions across most of country from 27 July.
- **Pakistan**: Government bans domestic air travel for unvaccinated people from 1 August because of COVID-19.

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

 Asia, Middle East: Update: Emirates suspends flights from Bangladesh, India, Pakistan and Sri Lanka until 28 July because of COVID-19.
