## ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and some countries still extend their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our daily update informs you in short about the latest information.

Please note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information is based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures, updated via our ATPI Alerts.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

### **Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions**

#### **EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:**

- **No updates**

#### **AFRICA:**

- **Egypt:** South Sinai's Taba Airport to start receiving international flights from 5 August

#### **MIDDLE EAST:**

- **Jordan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports resumption of regular commercial international flights from certain countries may resume as of 5 August
- **Kuwait:** Update: Government to allow citizens and residents to travel to, from country from 1 August

### AMERICAS:

- **U.S.:** Update: Commercial flights to resume at Paine Field Airport in Snohomish, Washington, on 1 August
- **Brazil:** Update: Government reopens international air travel to foreign tourists
- **Costa Rica:** Update Government to begin economic reopening 1-9 August

### ASIAN / AUSTRALIAN COUNTRIES:

- **Philippines:** Several international flights to resume at Pampanga's Clark International Airport on 1 August

### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Africa, Asia, Europe, Middle East:** Update: **Kuwait Airways** to resume flights to several countries from 1 August
- **Belarus, Estonia, Poland:** Update: **Belavia** resumes flights to Warsaw from 29 July and Tallinn from 1 August
- **Russia, Turkey:** Update: **Turkish Airlines** to resume flights to St. Petersburg from 2 August

## Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

### AIRLINES:

- **Solomon Islands:** Update: **Solomon Airlines** to extend suspension of international flights until 24 October

### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Europe:** Update: Sweden will scrap recommendations against travel to four European countries
- **Australia:** Security Message: U.S. Mission reports Greater Sydney has been declared a COVID-19 hotspot, quarantine restrictions imposed
- **Australia:** South Australia authorities shut borders to anyone traveling from Victoria because of COVID-19
- **Poland:** Update: Government extends partial ban on international flights to 11 August
- **Bahamas:** Update: Government implements two additional weekend lockdowns as COVID-19 cases increase
