#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- India: Update: Maharashtra government extends COVID-19 lockdown restrictions until 31 January 2021
- India: Update: Commercial international flights will remain suspended until 31 January 2021
- Kuwait: Update: Flight ban imposed on 35 countries will continue after borders reopen
- Myanmar: Update: Government extends entry restriction for travelers to 31 January 2021

- Canada: Authorities to require all arriving air passengers to show negative COVID-19 test
- Ireland, South Africa, U.K.: Update: Irish government extends ban on travel from South Africa, U.K. until 6 January
- Philippines: Update: Sulu province to close borders 4-17 January because of new COVID-19 variant
- Colombia: Update: Antioquia officials extend curfew in Medellin, other areas until 3 January amid COVID-19 concerns
- Myanmar: Update: Government extends suspension of international flights until 31 January
- Australia: Update: South Australia authorities impose border restrictions on New South Wales; gatherings limited, masks required in Victoria after increase in COVID-19 cases
- Netherlands: Update: Health official says national lockdown likely to last until mid-February
