ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client.

The world is still changing by the hour due to the global effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Just as some countries are seeing restrictions eased, others are finding that lockdowns and travel bans are being extended. Airlines are now beginning to resume operations, albeit with a limited capacity in many regions. In this global update we aim to inform you on the latest travel guidance and information.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Australia: Authorities in Sydney to ease COVID-19 lockdown for fully vaccinated people starting 11 October
- Italy: Update: Nightclubs to reopen at 100 percent capacity, restrictions to ease for cultural and sports venues from 11 October; COVID-19 health certificate required
- Brazil, India, South Africa, U.K.: Brazilian government lifts entry restrictions for travelers from India, South Africa and U.K.
- Vietnam: Update: Government will allow domestic flights to resume from 10 October
- Global: Update: England removes 47 countries from its COVID-19 travel red list
- India: Update: Government to reopen country to tourists from 15 October
- Asia, U.S.: Update: Singapore government to lift quarantine requirement for vaccinated visitors from South Korea on 12 November; quarantine requirement for American travelers expected to end before end of year
- Australia: Authorities in Sydney to ease COVID-19 lockdown for fully vaccinated people starting 11
 October

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Canada: Porter Airlines resumes flights to Sault Ste. Marie, Sudbury and Timmins
- Norway, Sweden: Direct trains between Oslo and Stockholm to resume on 12 December following COVID-19-related suspension

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Cambodia: Update: Phnom Penh authorities extend COVID-19 restrictions until 14 October
- Morocco, Russia: Moroccan authorities suspend direct flights between countries
- Macau: Update: Government imposes further travel restrictions because of COVID-19
- Canada: Government imposes COVID-19 vaccine mandate for air, train and ship passengers
- Australia: Authorities in Snowy Monaro, New South Wales, extend COVID-19 lockdown until 11 October

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

• U.K.: Disruption for South Western Railway's West of England line due to crew shortage expected on Saturdays until at least 11 December
