ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Norway:** Update: Government to begin easing some COVID-19 restrictions on 16 April; continues to advise against domestic, international travel
- **Greece:** Update: Greek authorities will lift quarantine restrictions from next week for travelers from EU, Israel, Serbia, United Arab Emirates, U.K., U.S. with vaccine or negative COVID-19 test

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Czech Republic, Russia: Smartwings** to resume Prague-St Petersburg flights on 29 April following COVID-19-related suspension

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Poland:** Update: Government to extend most COVID-19 restrictions until 25 April; hotels to remain closed until 3 May
- **Ukraine:** Update: Kyiv will remain in strict lockdown until 30 April
- **Morocco, Tunisia:** Update: Morocco authorities will suspend flights with Tunisia from 15 April until further notice because of COVID-19
- **France, Iran:** Iranian aviation authority suspends all flights to, from France because of COVID-19
- **Portugal:** Update: Government extends COVID-19 state of emergency for 15 days
- **Argentina:** Update: Government extends nightly stay-home order for Buenos Aires city, province amid COVID-19 concerns
- **Cambodia:** Government places Phnom Penh under lockdown because of rise in COVID-19 cases
- **India:** Authorities impose weekend lockdowns in New Delhi to curb steep rise in COVID-19 infections
- **India:** Travelers from Maharashtra, Punjab and Kerala will now have to produce negative COVID-19 at Patna International Airport
- **Portugal, Spain:** Update: Authorities extend closure of Spain's border with Portugal until at least 3 May to control spread of COVID-19

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Russia, Turkey:** Update: **Turkish Airlines** suspends flights to Russia until 1 June
- **South Africa, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Emirates** extends suspension of flights from South Africa until 30 April
