ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour due to the global effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Just as some countries are seeing restrictions eased, others are finding that lockdowns and travel bans are being extended. Airlines are now beginning to resume operations, albeit with a limited capacity in many regions.

In this global update we aim to inform you on the latest travel guidance and information.

We wish to share with you the latest requirements for **Seafarers travelling to Panama, effective immediately.**

- All seafarers entering PTY must complete a digital health declaration form and obtain a QR code before arrival. Please click on the link to access the health declaration: <https://www.panamadigital.gob.pa/RegistroPacoViajero>
- [Traveldoc.com](https://www.traveldoc.com) displays the new rule for entering Panama as follows: Covid-19 Form required: All passengers (including diplomats, nationals, residents, tourists, seamen, and crew members) must complete an Electronic Health Declaration (Declaración Jurada De Salud) online 24 hours prior to arrival and present the generated QR code on arrival confirming that they have submitted the form. Minors can be included on their parent/guardian's form.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Japan:** Update: Government will ease quarantine requirements from 1 October
- **Jordan, Syria:** Update: Jordanian government will fully reopen its main border crossing with Syria from 29 September
- **Japan:** Update: Government to lift COVID-19 state of emergency in all regions 30 September; some restrictions to remain in effect

- **United Arab Emirates, U.K.:** Emirates will resume flights between Dubai and London from 10 December

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- No update

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Australia:** Update: Authorities extend COVID-19 lockdown in Cowra until 5 October; [stay-at-home order lifted for Yass Valley](#)
- **Canada, Morocco:** Update: Canadian government extends ban on direct flights to Morocco until 29 October because of COVID-19
- **India:** Update: Civil aviation authorities extend ban on international passenger flights until 31 October
- **China, Macau:** Update: Authorities extend travel restrictions for travelers from Macau to Zhuhai until 30 September
- **France:** Update: Government may extend health passport rules until next summer
