### ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour due to the global effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Just as some countries are seeing restrictions eased, others are finding that lockdowns and travel bans are being extended. Airlines are now beginning to resume operations, albeit with a limited capacity in many regions.

In this global update we aim to inform you on the latest travel guidance and information.

#### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Canada, Dominican Republic:** Dominican Republic government updates entry requirements for Canadians, eliminating need for COVID-19 testing upon arrival
- **Global:** Russian government will resume passenger flights to Denmark, Djibouti, New Zealand, Peru, South Africa from 5 October
- **Malta:** Government updates list of quarantine-free travel countries
- **Sweden:** Authorities confirm that most remaining COVID-19 restrictions will be lifted 29 September
- **Global:** Update: Swedish authorities update non-EU ban to allow entry of fully vaccinated people from seven countries
- **Portugal:** Update: Authorities to lift most COVID-19 restrictions from 1 October; requirements remain for air travel
- **Vietnam:** Update: Authorities plan to reopen resort island of Phu Quoc to foreign visitors on 20 November; COVID-19 tests to be required
- **Uganda:** Update: Government eases some COVID-19 restrictions

##### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Turkey, U.K.:** **British Airways** resumes flights between Istanbul and London
- **Thailand:** **Bangkok Airways** will resume flights from Bangkok to Trat from 1 October
- **Turkey, U.K.:** Update: **Jet2** resumes flights to Turkey as country is removed from U.K.'s COVID-19 red list

#### Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- **Laos:** Update: Government imposes lockdown in Vientiane, bans travel between COVID-19-hit provinces
- **Jamaica:** Update: 'No movement days' for October and other COVID-19 control measures reported
- **Ukraine:** Update: Authorities tighten COVID-19 restrictions following increase in new cases

### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- **Global:** Update: **TUI** cancels more flights, holidays until late October, early November following latest government COVID-19 travel review
