### ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

##### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Maldives:** Government eases some travel restrictions
- **Cyprus:** Update: Government will reopen to vaccinated tourists from 65 countries starting 10 May
- **U.K.:** Update: Further COVID-19 restrictions ease from today in Scotland
- **Azerbaijan, Pakistan:** Azerbaijan's authorities may resume direct flights with Pakistan
- **Malta:** Update: Government plans to fully reopen for tourism on 1 June
- **Hong Kong, Singapore:** Update: Air travel bubble between countries will start on 26 May
- **Australia, New Zealand:** Update: New Zealand government to reopen quarantine-free travel with Western Australia from 28 April
- **Europe, U.S.:** Update: Fully vaccinated U.S. travelers will be able to visit the European Union this summer
- **Europe:** Slovakia exempts specific groups of people from quarantine and COVID-19 test requirements for entry
- **Portugal:** Update: Government will end COVID-19 state of emergency on 30 April
- **Spain:** Update: Andalusia government to permit travel between provinces beginning 29 April; curfew, regional border closures remain in effect
- **Poland:** Update: Hotels to reopen on 8 May; other COVID restrictions to be relaxed throughout the month

##### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Costa Rica, U.S.:** **Southwest Airlines** plans to resume flights between countries in early June
- **Libya, Tunisia:** **Afriqiyah Airways** will resume flights from Libya to Tunis after end of Ramadan

- **Finland: Finnair** will resume, increase flights this summer
- **Nigeria, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Emirates** expected to resume flights in, out of Nigeria 'soon'
- **North America:** Update: **Sunwing** will resume flights from Atlantic Canada to some Caribbean and Mexico destinations from January 2022
- **Peru, Spain: LATAM Airlines Peru** plans to resume flights between Lima and Madrid from 1 June
- **Panama, Venezuela: Copa Airlines** will increase flights from Panama to Caracas and Maracaibo from 30 April

## Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

### AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Bangladesh, India:** Update: Bangladesh authorities impose ban on entry of travelers from India via land ports because of COVID-19; air travel also suspended
- **Global:** German government classifies Cape Verde, India, Oman, Qatar and Tunisia as new COVID-19 'high incidence areas'; Albania and Moldova downgraded
- **India:** Update: Karnataka will enter two-week lockdown because of COVID-19
- **Germany, India:** Update: German government bans some flights, travelers from India because of rising cases of COVID-19
- **Turkey:** Update: Government imposes nationwide 'full closure' until 17 May because of COVID-19
- **India, Malaysia:** Malaysian government to temporarily ban flights to, from India
- **Australia, India:** Update: Australian authorities to suspend all direct flights from India until 15 May because of COVID-19
- **Cambodia:** Update: Government extends lockdown in Phnom Penh and Takmao until 5 May
- **Global:** All passenger traffic from Brazil, India, South Africa to Belgium will be temporarily banned because of COVID-19
- **Global:** Nigerian government to impose travel restrictions on Brazil, India, Turkey because of COVID-19
- **Denmark:** Update: Danish authorities keep in place travel restrictions for some countries until further notice
- **Estonia:** Update: Government extends existing COVID-19 entry restrictions for travelers until 2 May
- **Global:** Update: Nationals from some countries will be subject to stricter quarantine requirements when entering Lithuania
- **Finland:** Update: Government prolongs existing entry restrictions until 25 May
- **Cambodia, India, Philippines:** Philippines government will ban travelers coming from India from 29 April until 14 May to prevent spread of COVID-19 variant; Cambodia announces similar ban
- **India, Spain:** Spanish government will enforce quarantine on all travelers from India
- **Australia:** Update: Western Australia authorities to reduce number of incoming international travelers, close three quarantine hotels following COVID-19 case
- **Asia, Middle East, Norway:** Norwegian government imposes mandatory hotel quarantine for arrivals from several countries because of COVID-19

### AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **India: North Western Railway** cancels dozens of trains because of COVID-19

- **India:** Update: Noida Metro Rail Corporation suspends operations on Saturday and Sunday as weekend lockdown extended until 15 May in Uttar Pradesh
- **Philippines, United Arab Emirates:** Update: Several **Philippine Airlines** flights between Dubai and Manila canceled because of COVID-19 travel restrictions
- **Fiji, New Zealand:** Update: **Air New Zealand** cancels flight between countries after travel restrictions imposed
- **Argentina:** **JetSmart** will suspend Bariloche, Mendoza, Neuquen, Rosario and Salta routes in May
- **India, Iraq:** **Iraqi Airways** suspends flights to, from India until further notice because of surge in COVID-19 cases
