# ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The world is still changing by the hour due to the global effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Just as some countries are seeing restrictions eased, others are finding that lockdowns and travel bans are being extended. Airlines are now beginning to resume operations, albeit with a limited capacity in many regions. In this global update we aim to inform you on the latest travel guidance and information.

#### Important notice for new arrivals into Mumbai International Airport India

Please review new guidelines for arrivals into Mumbai International Airport in India as per attached document.

### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- Global: Update: Israeli authorities lift ban on travel to Georgia, Spain; ban on travel to Brazil, Bulgaria, Mexico, Turkey continues
- Anguilla: All COVID-19 quarantine requirements lifted for international visitors staying at hotels and villas
- Angola: Economic activities affected by COVID-19 expected to gradually return to normal in Luanda

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- India, United Arab Emirates: Air India resumes flights from Indore to Dubai as COVID-19
  restrictions eased
- South Africa: Kulula will resume flights between East London and Johannesburg from 4 September
- India, U.K.: British Airways will resume flights between Chennai and London from 2 September
- Nigeria: Train services will resume between Kano and Lagos on 3 September

## Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

Asia, Middle East: Update: Philippine government extends travel restrictions for 10 countries until
 5 September

- Albania: Government imposes fresh travel restrictions starting from 6 September
- Italy, U.S.: Italian government adds testing, self-isolation requirements for U.S. travelers after European Union recommends its members to remove U.S. from safe travel list
- Global: Update: Cyprus government updates list of COVID-19 countries, Germany added to 'red' list
- **Spain:** Update: Spanish government extends COVID-19 entry restrictions on nonessential travel for visitors from most countries outside EU until 30 September
- Bulgaria: Update: Government imposes new COVID-19 restrictions amid increase in cases

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- Ireland, U.K.: Loganair confirms suspension of Donegal-Glasgow flights from end of current summer season
- Hong Kong, Turkey: Update: Turkish Airlines' flights to Hong Kong also suspended until 11
   September after arriving passengers test positive for COVID-19
