ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

The world is still changing by the hour during this COVID pandemic outbreak. Many travel bans are being eased or lifted and other countries still extend or expand their current travel bans. Airlines slowly start up their network again, although with lower capacity. Our 3-weekly update informs you in short about the latest information.

Update Philippines for seafarers

In light of the recent update on the travel restrictions for travelers coming from India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Oman and UAE where the PH government will now accepted as long as below conditions are met:

1. **Approval from Bureau of Quarantine (BOQ)** must be submitted to the airlines operating (if taking commercial flight) **72 hours** before departure. As this needs to be confirmed before providing the OKTB
2. **Negative RT-PCR** test taken **48 hours** prior departure
3. **Undergo 14-day facility-based quarantine**, date of arrival being day 1.

In addition, all fully vaccinated (in the PH) individuals, will still be required to undergo 7-day facility-based quarantine, for the complete guidelines please refer to the IATF Resolution.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **Spain, U.K.:** Update: Canary Islands lift negative COVID-19 test requirement for vaccinated travelers from U.K.
- **Morocco:** Update: Government plans to allow international flights to resume from 9 or 10 June
- **India:** Update: Government announces plan to resume metro services in Delhi from 7 June with 50 percent capacity
- **Europe, Japan:** European Union eases COVID-19 restrictions for visitors from Japan

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **South Africa, U.S.:** **United Airlines** resumes direct flights from New York to Johannesburg
- **Denmark, Japan:** **SAS** will resume flights between Copenhagen and Tokyo from 1 July

- **Austria, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Air Arabia** to resume direct flights between Sharjah and Vienna from 15 October
- **Qatar, United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Qatar Airways** to resume flights to, from Sharjah from 1 July
- **Morocco:** Update: State of emergency extended until 10 July

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- **India:** Update: Authorities in Tamil Nadu announce extension of lockdown to 14 June amid ongoing COVID-19 pandemic
- **India:** Update: Government extends COVID-19 lockdown in Meghalaya until 14 June
- **India:** Update: Mizoram government extends COVID-19 lockdown in Aizawl until 14 June
- **India:** Update: Goa government extends lockdown until 14 June because of COVID-19
- **China:** Update: Passengers leaving Guangzhou required to present negative COVID-19 test from noon on 7 June as cases increase; most flights at Guangzhou airport remain canceled
- **Global:** Update: **Oman** government adds Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam to travel ban list
- **Greece:** Update: Authorities extend air travel restrictions for international flights from majority of third countries until 14 June because of COVID-19
- **Taiwan:** Update: Government extends COVID-19 restrictions until 28 June

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- **Poland, Ukraine:** Update: **Ukraine International Airlines** reviews plan to resume flights to Poland starting 18 June
- **United Arab Emirates, Vietnam:** Update: **Emirates** suspends its flights from Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City to Dubai until further notice amid COVID-19 restrictions
