ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Slowly but steadily we see the world opening up again. Although all countries still have extra travel restrictions in place, these rules and restrictions are getting stabilized. As the number of changes decreases, we have decided to **end our 3-weekly overviews starting 1**st **November 2021**.

We have been more than happy to inform you about all Covid-19 related changes over the course of the last 1,5 years and hope to have offered you some guidance.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Kuwait: Government lifts all COVID-19 restrictions for vaccinated people; Kuwait Airport will resume operating at full capacity from 24 October
- Iraq, Saudi Arabia: Iraqi authorities announce resumption of flights to, from Saudi Arabia following suspension because of COVID-19
- Kenya: Government lifts nationwide curfew
- Israel: Update: Government to allow vaccinated, recovered travelers to enter country starting 1
 November following COVID-19 ban
- Global: Thailand's government to allow vaccinated visitors from 46 countries starting 1 November

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Mexico, U.K.: TUI Airways will resume flights to Puerto Vallarta in November
- Korea, U.S.: Korean Air Lines will resume flights to Hawaii from 3 November

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Sri Lanka: Update: Authorities extend inter-province travel ban until 31 October to halt spread of COVID-19
- **Serbia**: Authorities will make COVID-19 'health pass' mandatory for access to hotels, restaurants and bars in the evenings
- **Europe, Morocco**: Authorities will suspend direct flights with Germany, Netherlands and U.K. because of COVID-19 concerns starting from 21 October

- Russia: Update: President approves proposal for workplace shutdown from 30 October to 7
 November because of COVID-19; may begin earlier or extended in some regions
- Russia: Update: Moscow authorities to reimpose lockdown measures from 28 October because of rise in COVID-19 cases
- China: Update: Hundreds of inbound and outbound flights canceled at main airports in Xi'an and Lanzhou because of new COVID-19 cases
- **China: Update**: Flights, trains canceled in several northern cities amid strengthened COVID-19 prevention and control measures
- Singapore: Update: Government will extend social curbs to contain spread of COVID-19
