ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client.

Slowly but steadily we see the world opening up again. Although all countries still have extra travel restrictions in place, these rules and restrictions are getting stabilized. As the number of changes decreases, we have decided to **end our 3-weekly overviews starting 1**st **November 2021**.

We have been more than happy to inform you about all Covid-19 related changes over the course of the last 1,5 years and hope to have offered you some guidance.

Adjusted guidelines for Crew changes in Singapore

With the exception of short-term visitors, travellers from Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka with a 14-day travel history to these countries will now be allowed to enter Singapore. All travellers, however, will be allowed to <u>transit</u> through Singapore.

These six countries will now be placed in Category IV, meaning that arrivals will have to serve a 10-day stay-home notice (SHN) at dedicated SHN facilities.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- Australia: Update: South Australia government to reopen border to fully vaccinated domestic travelers, reduce COVID-19 guarantine period for international arrivals from 23 November
- Australia, Singapore, Switzerland: Update: Singapore authorities to permit quarantine-free entry for vaccinated travelers from Australia and Switzerland from 8 November
- **Vietnam:** Aviation authorities plan to resume international flights later this year; flights expected to remain grounded if quarantine rule remains
- U.S.: Update: President Biden imposes new international travel vaccine rules, lifting severe restrictions
- Argentina, France: French authorities ease restrictions for travelers from Argentina; other Green List countries reported
- Cambodia: Update: Authorities waive COVID-19 hotel quarantine for fully vaccinated tourists starting 30 November
- Australia: Update: Citizens, permanent residents fully vaccinated against COVID-19 able to leave country without exemption starting 1 November

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

Australia, U.S.: Hawaiian Airlines will resume flights between Honolulu and Sydney from 13
December

Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

AREAS & AIRPORTS:

- China: Update: Authorities in northern region reimpose lockdowns across 11 provinces after COVID-19 outbreak
- **Cyprus:** Update: Authorities imposes quarantine, double testing requirements for travelers from Iceland, Netherlands, Oman, Poland; updates COVID-19 classifications for other countries
- **Estonia:** Update: Quarantine requirements, testing imposed for travelers from Cyprus and Netherlands because of COVID-19; other 'red list' countries reported
- **Czech Republic:** Update: Authorities impose quarantine rules for unvaccinated travelers from Cyprus, Netherlands, Poland; restrictions for other countries reported
- Australia: Update: Queensland's slow COVID-19 vaccine uptake could delay international travel to the state
- Hong Kong: Update: Government will tighten COVID-19 travel restrictions
- Indonesia: Tourists cancel Bali trips after new domestic travel rules announced
- **Spain:** Update: Authorities tighten entry restrictions for travelers from Czech Republic, Denmark, Greece, Liechtenstein and other regions, update high-risk list of countries
- **Lithuania:** Update: Government imposes travel rules for travelers from Cyprus, Czech Republic and Denmark; other red list countries reported
- Italy: Authorities impose entry restrictions for several countries, update COVID-19 list of countries

AIRLINES / TRAIN:

- Global: Update: TUI updates list of flight cancellations, Morocco added to the list
- New Zealand: Air New Zealand cancels some domestic flights from 2 November to 6 December because of uncertainty of alert level restrictions
