# ATPI Alerts Travel Opportunities per Country during Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Slowly but steadily we see the world opening up again. Although all countries still have extra travel restrictions in place, these rules and restrictions are getting stabilized. As the number of changes decreases, we have decided to **end our 3-weekly overviews starting 1**st **November 2021**.

We have been more than happy to inform you about all Covid-19 related changes over the course of the last 1,5 years and hope to have offered you some guidance.

### Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- Italy: Update: Authorities allow travelers from Bangladesh, Brazil, India and Sri Lanka to enter country for essential purposes
- **Czech Republic:** Update: Authorities suspend self-isolation rules for unvaccinated and unrecovered travelers from high risk areas
- **U.K.:** Update: Colombia, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Haiti, Panama, Peru and Venezuela will be removed from England's travel red list
- Myanmar: Update: Authorities lift stay-at-home orders for 44 townships
- U.K.: Update: London Tube's Waterloo and City lines to resume full service from 22 November following COVID-19-related disruption
- Australia: Update: COVID-19 restrictions ease in Canberra
- Egypt: Flights between Sharm El Sheikh and Luxor resume

#### **AIRLINES / TRAIN:**

- Australia, Qatar: Qatar Airways will resume daily flights between Doha and Sydney, Melbourne from 1 December
- Nigeria, U.S.: Delta Air Lines will resume direct flights between Lagos and New York on 8
  December
- Argentina, Chile, Peru: LATAM Airlines will resume flights from Lima, Santiago to Cordoba from 15
   November
- Argentina, Panama: Copa Airlines will resume flights to Cordoba and Mendoza from 16 November
- Bangladesh, Singapore: Biman Bangladesh Airlines will resume flights between Dhaka and Singapore from 28 October

## Areas, airlines & airports imposing further restrictions

#### **AREAS & AIRPORTS:**

- Denmark: Government announces new COVID-19 entry rules
- **Ukraine:** Authorities in Kyiv tighten lockdown restrictions because of spike in COVID-19 cases; negative test or vaccine certificate will also be mandatory to use public transport
- Morocco: Update: Government extends state of emergency until 30 November
